

#### Nominations open

#### **Tuesday 23 August**

Interested in running for council? You will need to nominate to become a candidate before you can start campaigning your candidacy.

#### Nominations close

#### 12 noon, Tuesday 6 September

You must submit your nomination before the deadline

#### Voting opens

#### Friday 14 October to Thursday 20 October.

Ballot packs will be sent to the mailing address included on during your enrolment. Keep an eye out for it in the mail! Instructions and guides on how to vote are included in the ballot pack.

#### Voting closes

#### 5:00 pm, Thursday 10 November

You must return your ballot papers so they reach the electoral commission before this deadline.

#### Scrutiny and count

#### 9:00 am, Saturday 12 November

Counting begins and results are posted progressively to the ECSA website.

Planning for the Eyre Peninsula Local Government Association Conference is well underway. We have some amazing guest speakers confirmed and look forward to welcoming local EP Councils, important stakeholders and conference sponsors to the event in September.

#### DISTRICT PROJECT UPDATE

With plenty of projects happening throughout the District, we thought an update was in order!

RayGen Solar Farm - The Project has received Crown Sponsorship from the State Government for development approval. Raygen anticipates they will commence construction of the Solar Farm in the 3rd quarter of 2023.

CH4 Seaweed - CH4 Seaweed have commenced construction at Arno Bay and have employed their first few employees. Council is extremely excited for the relationship between Cleanseas and CH4 and we look forward to following the production of seaweed in our District to reduce the environmental impact of fish farming and livestock.

Affordable Housing Program - Following Community Consultation, Council has now adopted the Affordable Housing Policy. We are progressing towards looking at best construction and funding options.

Boarding House - The Boarding House Facility is still in the Development Approval process. Thankyou to those who participated in the Community Consultation.

Cleve Playspace - The Cleve Playspace is on track to be completed mid October. It's coming along well and we know the community is excited for its completion!

Cleve RV Park - The Cleve RV Park is completed and looks fantastic. We welcomed plenty of visitors over the Field Days week and look forward to promoting the Park Australia wide.

Arno Bay Walking Trail - The new walking trail is being enjoyed by many walkers and cyclists. A beautiful walk, winding along the coastline from the boat ramp to Turnbull's Beach. The walk is awaiting signage which will be installed soon.
