The Shed is the final addition to the RV Park which has come together beautifully, providing our District with a fabulous option for our visiting campers and vanners!

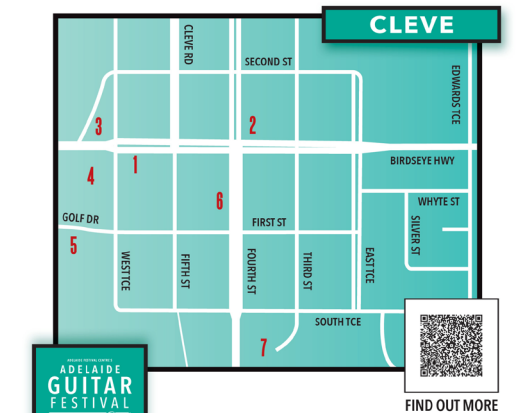


ARNO BAY WALKING TRAIL
