MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR

Wasn't it brilliant to see the Dis-Cleve trict showas cased part of the episode on HelloSA earlier in the month, such a great opportunity for our district. Year 11 / 12 Students from the Dis-Cleve trict Area

School visited myself and Councils' Manager for Infrastructure and Civil Works to talk about the future of work and finding employment. We discussed the future evolution of local government operations for the next 30 years and how a young person can establish a career in Local Government.

The CEO and myself attended a meeting with the Motor Trade Association of SA regarding increasing the number of apprentices being trained from 100 to 130-150 over the next few years and funding to support upgrade of facilities. Council are in support of this initiative and will co-contribute \$5000 towards the expansion of the MTA Training Centre Shed.

Cleve was the location for the EP Landscape Board Meeting, the elected members and myself were invited to attend, it was fantastic to catch up and discuss local issues.

Our towns came alive with visitors over the Easter Long weekend, with the Cleve RV park reporting a record number of 45 vans on one day.
