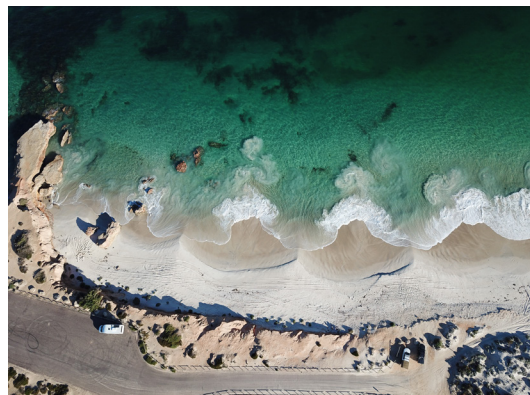
CHRISTMAS PAGEANT
